RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE FOR FUNDS TO ASSIST WITH A DRUG USE PREVENTION EDUCATION PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Ross Township Board of Trustees finds it necessary and desirable to provide drug use prevention education to the students of Ross Local Schools through the contract for School Resource Officers; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to apply for a grant from the Ohio Attorney General's 2019-2020 Drug Use Prevention Grant funds to assist with the essential cost during the undertaking said project; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the Police Chief apply to the Ohio Attorney General's Office for said Drug Use Prevention Grant funds by submitting and executing any documents required in connection with the grant application.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Ross Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1-A:

That the Board of Trustees authorizes application for a grant of \$9,850.00 for 2019-2020 Drug Use Prevention Grant funds through the Ohio Attorney General's Office to assist with a portion of the essential cost during the undertaking of the Ross Township 2019-2020 Drug Use Prevention Education Program for Ross Local Schools students.

SECTION 1-B:

That Chief Darryl J. Haussler, Ross Township Police Department, be and hereby is authorized to submit and execute any documents required in connection with the grant application authorized herein.

SECTION 2:

This resolution shall take effect on April 18, 2019 following the filing of this resolution with the Ross Township Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 3:







Program Description:

Officer David Liddil will provide instruction to Ross Local School students, Kindergarten through middle school providing them with the ability and knowledge to recognize and resist pressure they will encounter to experiment with drugs. Additional training will address gangs and violence with emphasis on maintaining a high level of self-esteem that will assist the student in making good decisions while improving his/her communication skills. Training will also be provided in the consequences of drug abuse, conflict resolution, and positive choices that can be made as an alternative to substance abuse.

Project Description:

Officer David Liddil will provide instruction to the students of Ross Local Schools by utilizing curriculum provided by the "D.A.R.E. OTC/RX Drug Abuse Program. This program will include providing students with the knowledge to recognize the dangers involved in using any drug, with particular emphasis on the elevated levels of danger that users of opiates encounter on a day to day basis. This training will also include how to identify those who choose to make bad decisions by using these dangerous drugs.
